Measures to assure an industrial development cooperation among world countries, resolution adopted by the General Assembly on its 2nd meeting, held on 3 April 2007

The General Assembly,

Observing with great faith the incredible work performed by the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) and those cooperating with UNCTAD,

Expressing its appreciation to the already great cooperation that is between nations all over the globe, much thanks to the United Nations Development Program (UNDP),

Acknowledging that the world today is full of injustices and that most of them could be solved only if every nation has the same financial possibilities to aid their people and people across the entire world in various manners, such as the right to pure water and the global struggle against lethal diseases,

Deeply concerned that some Member States misuse their financial and political influence to suppress other states that only possess a minor economical power,

Realises that the negotiations in the United Nations on this issue provide a greater global cooperation between countries on other issues and levels as well,

Reaffirms that to live in a glorious world of wealth and prosperity is a main priority to care for the environment to ensure a harmonious world to our children,

Noting the comprehensive review of the activities of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO), which has enabled it to become more focused and efficient organization, providing valuable contributions to the achievement of the international agreed development goals, including those contained in the Millennium Declaration,

Further realizing that governments have a primary responsibility to educate young people, to encourage them to seek training so as to increase their employability and to create an enabling environment that will promote youth employment,

Taking into account the important role played by the public administrations with respect to planning and provision of public services and the positive contribution to the creation of an enabling environment,

1. *Stresses* for the achievement of the internationally agreed development goals, including those contained in the United Nations Millennium Declaration, and *supports* work towards these goals;

2. *Encourages* the creation of a global forum in which the Member States, and foremost their companies will be able to:
 - (a) Cooperate on a national and international level;
 - (b) Device projects and programs for a sustainable development;
 - (c) Exchange ideas, material, employment and more for an improved and common global development;
3. *Requests* the General Assembly, within existing regular budget resources, or through voluntary contributions as available:
 - (a) To forge closer cooperation within the UN bodies, development agencies and multilateral financing institutions, as well as donors, as appropriate within their respective mandates, to improve global partnership for infrastructure development, including that related to disaster risk management, reconstruction and rehabilitation;
 - (b) To strengthen regional cooperation on infrastructure development by improving the effectiveness of existing regional and sub-regional initiatives in the field;
 - (c) To continue efforts to ascertain the views of the Member States to identify and address the investment needs and priorities of Members, and, as appropriate, of associate members, in infrastructure development, including that which contributes towards the integration of regional infrastructure;
 - (d) To examine, promote and support the use of microfinance's to improve infrastructure development on a local level;
4. *Demands* the Member States to promote a larger assistance to aiding organizations, such as UNCTAD and UNDP based on their Gross National Product (GNP);
5. *Further demands* all UN bodies that were mentioned above to remain continuously in contact within the organization and report on a regular basis regarding the proceeding progress in these issues under the supervision of the UN;
6. *Emphasises* the special needs to aid landlocked nations and small islands for a better development and to enable them to complete globally through industrial development;
7. *Further demands* measures for the industrialization of developing countries, and urges all governments to adopt and to implement development policies and strategies to unleash the productivity growth potential through private-sector development;
