Report by the President of the Security Council Mr. Andrea Cuono, under Rule 133 of the Rules of Procedure of the General Assembly and the Security Council, at the 2nd meeting of the General Assembly, held on 23 March 2010

Honourable President of the General Assembly,
Secretary-General,
Chairmen,
Delegates,
Ladies and Gentlemen,

As you all know the United Nations Security Council is charged with the effective and quick action of the UN. In fact the Member States confer on this organ the principal responsibility for the peacekeeping and international security.

Moreover, they allowed the Security Council to represent the United Nations as all.

The debates of these days gave profitable results thank to the delegates who played an active part in the discussions about some of the most unsolved questions that still afflicts the world right now, such as the measures to be adopted to solve the question of sovereignty in Palestine, the situation in Chad and the UN mission in the Democratic Republic of Congo, and last, but not least, the Security Council discussed the resolution that has been approved in the General Assembly about the refinancing and the extension of the UNAMA.

In the Security Council five resolutions have been discussed, only three of them have passed.

The first resolution we debated on was that about the urgent necessity of effectively reforming the UN mission in DR Congo. What came out from this resolution is the request for an extension of the mission for one year from the current expiration date, and the creation of a peacekeeping organization of Congo. This is one of the resolutions passed with the clear majority of the votes, together with the one about the situation in Chad.

It specifically concerns the condition of refugees of neighbouring countries. It can be solved with the extension of the mandate of MINURCAT until May 2012, with the assistance and cooperation of the UN mission by guaranteeing security in refugees camps and necessary equipments to DIS. Furthermore, it has been proposed the creation of an African Union's mission parallel to MINURCAT to support its actions and encourage the parties to run for transparent elections inspired to democracy.

Unfortunately, the third topic concerning Palestinian question, the most debated one, did not reach any solution, even if delegates have prepared two different resolutions

about. The issue remained unsolved due to the irremediable disagreement of the P5 Members.

At the end, we I am proud to announce that the whole Security Council voted in favour of the resolution first approved this morning by the General Assembly about the mission in Afghanistan.
